CURRENT UNDERSTANDING & TREATMENT

Duchenne is the most common, terminal, childhood, genetic illness. Recent innovative research has uncovered more information on Duchenne including its etiology, pathophysiology, and effective treatments. It is vital that we, as treating therapists, understand the disease and deliver appropriate treatments based on the current evidence.

This course is ideal for physical therapists and assistants, occupational therapists and assistants, speech/language pathologists, adapted physical educators and would be beneficial for others involved in the care of persons with Duchenne such as educators, physicians, and nursing professionals.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Identify 4 medical tests which lead to a diagnosis of DMD.
- Identify the most common genetic mutation leading to DMD.
- Identify the current stage of DMD for the case studies.
- Identify 3 body systems affected by Duchenne.
- Choose 2 appropriate treatment interventions.
- Prescribe 3 appropriate exercises.
- List 4 other healthcare professionals in standard care.
